We also meet at least twice a year for moderation in core subject areas.

Our Office staff meet each term to support one another with administration issues, Finance, and GDPR.

The Headteachers work together daily and weekly, sharing good practice and ideas, developing policy and practice, seeking 'best value' for the school budgets, and for friendly, positive and professional support for each other!
