Road safety advice

Keeping pupils, parents, staff and residents safe is a priority for the Police and schools. As such we would like to bring to your attention the features around school which are in place to ensure everyone's safety.

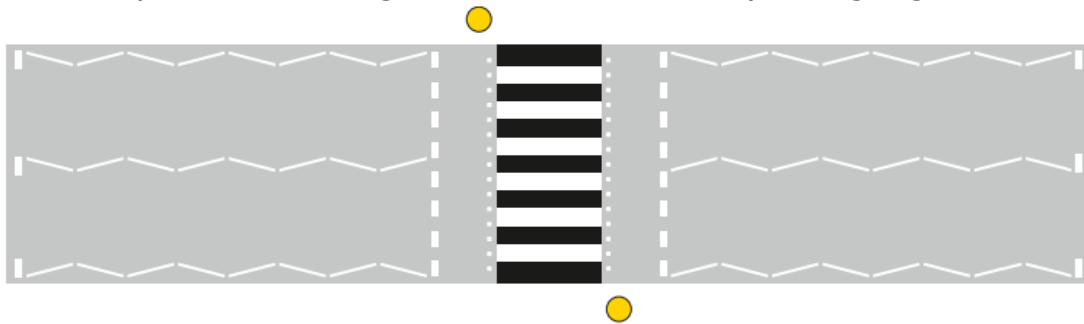
Many of these road features are covered by The Highway Code and are legal requirements.

If you disobey these rules you are committing a criminal offence. You may be fined, given penalty points on your licence or be disqualified from driving. In the most serious cases you may be sent to prison. Such rules are identified by the use of the words 'MUST/MUST NOT'

1) Please do not park on the zebra crossing on Highfield Road.

Rule 191 of the Highway Code states:

You MUST NOT park on a crossing or in the area covered by the zig-zag lines.



2) Please follow the instructions of the school crossing patrol.

Rule 105 of the Highway Code states:

You MUST obey signals given by police officers, traffic officers, traffic wardens and signs used by school crossing patrols.



3) Please do not drive or park on The Flat.

The Flat is a 'right of way'.

There is an agreement with the Council allowing vehicles to access the school. Residents are also permitted to access their houses.

A 'right of way' **does not** give "a right to park."

Parents are not allowed to park in the school premises, therefore parents should not drive or stop on the Flat as they are blocking the 'right of way' as well as putting pedestrians in danger.

4) Please do not park on Church Street.

Rule 240 of the Highway Code states:

You MUST NOT stop or park on a road marked with double white lines, even when a broken white line is on your side of the road.
